Any uncased rifle must either have the bolt/action removed or a breach plug inserted at all times except when firing a detail. Transgressors may be disqualified from the meeting at the discretion of the Range Committee.

Appleton Local Rules and Range safety (which can be found at the rear of both the 100Yds and 50M ranges) will also apply.

The committee reserve the right to reclassify anyone who has been entered in the wrong class.
