The event is Open to all comers, with A, B and C Classes, Juniors, Ladies, Veteran and Club Pairs.

Silverware trophies will be awarded to Winners of each class provided that they are County residents of Cheshire & North Wales.

For the <u>very first time</u>, we will be holding two separate competitions – an unsquadded Double Dewar match for the County Championship and a separate squadded 40 shot 50m Competion on electronic targets with decimal scoring. Competitors can elect to shoot in either or both competitions.

Due to limited space / time constraints on the Electronics Range the 50m Electronics match will be squadded and advance booking is essential to avoid disappointment.

The 50m Electronics Championship will be shot in accordance with the spirit of the ISSF Rules. There will be no equipment control.

Appleton Local Rules and Range Safety Rules (which can be found at the rear of both the 100Yds and 50M ranges) will also apply.

The committee reserve the right to reclassify anyone who has been entered in the wrong class. Aggregate winners in the 2019 shoot must enter the next highest Class.
